

Transfer Release Form

(For consideration for Financial Aid)

According to the National Association of Schools of Music (NASM) Code of Ethics, Article IV, Section 3, "a transferring student who has not completed a degree program may be considered for financial aid during the first term of enrollment in the new institution only if the music executive (e.g. the Dean or Director of the School of Music) of the school from which the student is transferring specifically indicates to the music executive of the prospective new institution that permission will be given for the student to withdraw from the commitments, obligations, and benefits of his or her financial award." It also states that "approval must be sought prior to the offering of the financial award by the institution to which the student may transfer." Please note that a financial award can include assistantships, fellowships, and/or scholarships.
