

Post-Baccalaureate Requirements for Georgia Certification (Music P-12)

In addition to a baccalaureate degree in music, the Hodgson School requires completion of the following courses for T-4 certification in music:

MUSI 3110 – Music Techniques and Experiences for Children (3 hours)

MUSI 3130 – Choral Techniques and Field Experiences (OR 3 hours)

MUSI 3150 – Instrumental Techniques and Field Experiences

EFND 2110 - Foundations in Education (3 hours)

EPSY 2130 - Learning and Development (3 hours)

SPED 2000 - Survey of Special Education (OR 3 hours)

MUSI 5450 – Music for Exceptional Children

MUSI 3480 – Introduction to Conducting (2 hours)

And 2 credits from the following (2 hours):

- MUSI 3490 – Choral Conducting
- MUSI 3500 – Band Conducting
- MUSI 3510 – Orchestral Conducting

MUSI 3410 – String Instrumental Techniques (1 hour)

MUSI 3420 – Woodwind Instrumental Techniques (1 hour)

MUSI 3430 – Brass Instrumental Techniques (1 hour)

MUSI 3440 – Percussion Techniques (1 hour)

EMUS 5460 – Student Teaching (12 hours)

Additional requirements:

- Pass the Hodgson School of Music Piano Proficiency examination;
- Pass GACE I and II exams
(Register through College of Education, Educational Testing Service)

Students who do not have a baccalaureate degree in music must demonstrate proficiency on an instrument or voice and complete the following courses or show proficiency through examination:
